

Marching Band Grading Rubric for Daily and Tuesday Night Rehearsals
Counts as a 30% Minor Assignment

Grade	Requirements
4	Always maintains a positive attitude throughout rehearsal and demonstrates good rehearsal discipline and technique. Always shows respect towards staff members and fellow students. Attends 90% or more of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)
3	Usually maintains a positive attitude throughout rehearsal and demonstrates good rehearsal discipline and technique. Usually shows respect towards staff members and fellow students. Attends 80% or more of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)
2	Usually maintains a positive attitude throughout rehearsal and demonstrates good rehearsal discipline and technique. Usually shows respect towards staff members and fellow students. Attends 70% or more of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)
1	Sometimes maintains a positive attitude throughout rehearsal and demonstrates good rehearsal discipline and technique. Sometimes shows respect towards staff members and fellow students. Attends 60% or more of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)
.5	Rarely maintains a positive attitude throughout rehearsal and demonstrates good rehearsal discipline and technique. Rarely shows respect towards staff members and fellow students. Attends 50% or more of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)
0	Attends less than 50% of rehearsals on time and prepared. (Prepared is defined as having all assigned music, a dot book, a pencil, four poker chips, a nail pouch and the student's assigned instrument or equipment.)

Grading Rubric for Performances
Counts as either a 30% Minor Assignment or a 70% Major Assignment

Grade	Requirements
4	Arrives at the designated location by the assigned report time. Has the proper uniform and required accessories. Has all required music and equipment for the performance. Is prepared to perform all musical selections at proficiency of 90% or better. Maintains a positive attitude and a professional appearance and demeanor throughout the performance.
3	Arrives at the designated location by the assigned report time. Has most of the proper uniform and required accessories. Has most of the required music and equipment for the performance. Is prepared to perform all musical selections at proficiency of 80% or better. Maintains a positive attitude and a professional appearance and demeanor throughout the performance.
2	Arrives at the designated location but is tardy for the assigned report time. Has most of the proper uniform and required accessories. Has most of the required music and equipment for the performance. Is prepared to perform all musical selections at proficiency of 70% or better. Does not maintain a positive attitude and a professional appearance and demeanor throughout the performance.
1	Attends the performance but is tardy for the performance start time. Arrives unprepared. Does not have a positive attitude and a professional appearance and demeanor throughout the performance.
.5	Attends the performance but does not perform or performs at an unacceptable level of proficiency. Does not have a positive attitude and a professional appearance and demeanor throughout the performance.
0	Does not attend the performance.
